

# AGER publication prize

## Gynecological Endocrinology, Menopause & Reproductive Medicine

### Guidelines

The aim of the prize is to reward the best publication conducted in Switzerland in the field of gynecological endocrinology, menopause and reproductive medicine.

<b>Papers to be considered</b>	<p>Any kind of papers related to Gynecological Endocrinology, Menopause and Reproductive Medicine, accepted for publication or published within a maximum of 12 months before the deadline will be considered.</p> <p>The major part of the study must have been conducted in Switzerland and the first author must reside and/or work in Switzerland at the time of the submission deadline.</p>
<b>Submission</b>	<p>The full paper must be submitted. If the paper is in press or has just been accepted, the manuscript, together with the confirmation of acceptance need to be completely submitted.</p>
<b>Deadline for submission</b>	<p>May 31<sup>st</sup> (midnight) only electronically to the SGRM administration, the host of the prize. E-Mail: <a href="mailto:administration@sgrm.org">administration@sgrm.org</a>.</p>
<b>Evaluation</b>	<p>Projects can only be evaluated when a minimum of three papers are submitted. The evaluating jury consists of the following persons (minimum of three jury members):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* President of AGER (jury president)</li><li>* Vice President of AGER or another defined person from the AGER board</li><li>* President SGRM</li><li>* Vice president of SGRM or another defined person from the SGRM board</li><li>* President SGEM</li><li>* Vice president of SGEM or another defined person from the SGEM board</li><li>* Another scientist or physician with scientific experience not working in the field of gynecological endocrinology, menopause and reproductive medicine</li></ul> <p>Authors or co-authors of submitted papers will be excluded from the evaluation. If less than three members remain in the committee, the president and/or other members of the scientific committee of the SGGG will be invited.</p>
<b>Evaluation criteria</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Originality (Is the study original?)</li><li>* Study design (Is the study design adequate?)</li><li>* Quality of data (Is the quality of the data adequate?)</li><li>* Presentation (Is the paper well written?)</li><li>* Significance (Is the paper relevant/significant in the context of basic and/or clinical research?)</li></ul> <p>Weight of the scores: (originality x2) + (design x2) + (quality of data x2) + (presentation x1) + (significance x4) = total score (Min = 11 ; Max = 55).</p> <p>Papers from young authors without a habilitation (being the 1<sup>st</sup> or corresponding author) will be preferred.</p>
<b>Reward</b>	<p>The first author will be rewarded CHF 1000,-. CHF 500,- are paid by the SGRM and CHF 500,- by the SGEM. The reward will be transferred either to a clinic's account or to the first author's personal bank account.</p>
<b>Award ceremony</b>	<p>The applicants will be honored at the SGGG conference. The winner can be invited to give a short presentation of his/her work.</p>
